**Activities**

Each day, campers participate in daily Bible classes, a chapel service, singing, evening campfires, and mail call. Recreational and developmental activities include softball, Ping-Pong, swimming, basketball, volleyball, tetherball, games, skit night, and banquet night.

**What to Bring:**

Each camper should bring an old Bible, bedding, swimsuit, notebook, pencil, flashlight, jacket, towels, sneakers, toilet articles, and clothes (enough for all week) including shorts (must be knee length), but no tank tops.

Do not bring radios/tape/CD players, cell phones, pagers, stereos, firearms, tobacco, drugs, axes, firecrackers, knives, musical instruments, valuable jewelry, pets: these are prohibited in the camp. Visitors must observe these rules also.

**Camp Contract**

Welcome to Camp Indogan. It is our goal to provide a week of Christian education, recreation, and fellowship. It is our desire that this week be one of Christian growth for all campers and staff. In order to ensure this environment, certain rules are necessary.

1. As a camper I must attend all chapel services, recreations, classes and planned activities.
2. I understand that girls cannot be around the boys' cabins and boys cannot be around the girls' cabins.
3. It is my privilege to enjoy Camp Indogan and therefore I will help keep my cabin and grounds neat and clean.
4. I will at no time wear shorts above the knee or tank tops.
